

Reuben Brasher and Guy Hill Brasher - 1880

Reuben was born in Randolph Utah 26 July 1878 to John Leasil and Eliza Christine Brasher. In September 1880 they left Randolph for Castle Valley along with two other families Stewarts and Howard.

They settled on Huntington Creek. Reuben attended Seminary which was taught by Abner E. Wall. Seminary was equivalent to High School. He worked for Leander Simon and the Miller Brothers on their stock ranches.

He attended B.Y.U. now called B.Y.U. After he graduated he became a bookkeeper for the Continental Oil Company.

While he was at B.Y.U. he met Guy May Hill and corresponded with her for some time. September 21, 1905 Reuben and Guy were married in the Manti temple.

Guy was the daughter of Robert Wimmer Hill and Lucinda Elmer Hill. Her parents moved to Lawrence from Payson in October 1879. They built a dug out and this was where Guy was born 6 January 1880.

Reuben and Guy went to work for Joe Johnson at his sawmill in Huntington. Guy cooked for the mill hands. In the fall the Hotel owned by Don Robbins was for sale and they bought it.

Their first child was born in February 5, 1909 lived 5 days.

their second child Ruby, born 9 February.

Reuben renewed a mission in the southern states.

In 1917 they leased the Hotel and moved to Lawrence

In 1918 he was appointed Clerk of Emery Co. Schools. held this position until 1938.

Reuben and Guy ~~also~~ held many positions in the Church

The 31 August 1940 the Brasher hotel was destroyed by fire

They moved back to Lawrence and remodelled the ranch home

In 1946 they moved back to Huntington.

Reuben passed away in Oct. 1957. and Guy in 1967

They had three living children at this time.
