

Harriet Edna Jensen born September 13, 1910 to Edward C. and Maude Eden Jensen. Edward was born in Spanish Fork, Utah and Maude in Cleveland, Utah. Both parents were early settlers of Cleveland.

As I was growing up, people farmed for a living. We raised nearly everything we ate. We had a large garden, a few cows, sheep, chickens, pigs, etc. Mother bottled pickles, jams, fresh fruit, all the vegetables she could cold pack, there were no pressure cookers. Mother made Every spring dad would slaughter pigs for summer use. Mother made brine of brown sugar, salt, etc. They would pack the meat in wooden barrels, pour brine over it, after the meat was cured it was covered with liquid smoke. One couldn't buy fresh vegetables or fruit from stores only on holidays were oranges and bananas available. We had plenty to eat but not much money. Summers the neighbors kids would gather and play outdoor games, or roast potatoes over a campfire etc. In the winter we would sleigh ride, skate and have parties at our homes.

We had nine grades at our school. Kids that lived out of town rode horses to school, and tied them to a hitching rack during school hours. I married Frank Jensen from Elmo, Utah born November 21, 1907 to Soren Peter and Eliza Hutchinson Jensen. Father born in Denmark. Mother born in Butterville, Utah moved to Elmo from Mapleton, Utah in 1910.

They had ten children four after they moved to Elmo. They bought

land by the Desert Lake.

Times were still hard when our children were small due to the depression. I washed clothes on washboards and heated water on coal stoves.
