that it is bona fide my intention to become a Citizen of the United States; and to renounce and abjure for ever, all allegiance and fidelity, to all and any Foreign Prince, Potentate, State and Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to Near 2^d King

of Sweden + Norway of whom I am a subject.
