This story about my grandma was the "Most Embarrassing Moment" when she was about ten years of age "My uncle that lived in Roosevelt at the time" had bought a pig from her aunt that lived in Murry but he had no way of getting it."So me and my sister had to pick straws to see who which one would have to clean the chicken coop and which one would have to ride the bus over to Roosevelt to deliver the pig so we picked straws and of course I picked the shortest one" so she had to take the pig to Roosevelt.

So got the pig and put it in a Gunny sack so nobody could see that she had a pig on the bus. She got on the bus and took the pig all the way from Murry to Roosevelt. While they were on the bus the pig would squeal and move around to try and get loose because it hated being in that sack.
