

BISHOP FRANCIS M. REYNOLDS, ~~1896-1898~~<sup>1896-1898</sup>, the son of Levi and Hannah Reynolds, was born in Mt. Pleasant, Utah, July 4, 1865. He grew up there and learned the trade of a Miller.

In 1886 he came to Castle Dale and engaged in milling. After one year he became Superintendent of the Eagle Flour Mill and operated it for six years. He owned a farm of 80 acres.

He was a member of the High Council, Assistant Superintendent of the Sunday School, and served as a Home Missionary. He was an earnest, industrious citizen. He was married in the Wanti Temple to Diantha Andersen, daughter of Soren and Hannah anderson. They were the parents of five children: Francis M., Rose H., Lillian, Elmer L., and Priel E. He was Bishop of the Castle Dale Ward from 1896 to 1898.
